Costumes:

Preschool/Mid-Year Reception:

- Plain red t-shirt
- Black pants or shorts
- Santa hat or reindeer antlers

Reception:

- Plain long sleeve top (any colour)
- Black pants
- Beanie
- Gloves

Year 1:

- Plain white t-shirt
- Bright coloured board shorts (plain or patterned)

Year 2:

- Plain white t-shirt
- Black pants or shorts and spikey hair (boys)
- Black bike shorts or leggings (girls)

Year 3:

- Plain, bright green t-shirt
- Black pants or shorts

Year 4:

- Plain white t-shirt
- Black pants or shorts

Year 5:

• Pyjamas (summer or winter)

Year 6/7:

- Plain white t-shirt
- Black pants or shorts
- Button up shirt (checked or plain) or zip up jacket (with or without hood)
- Cap hat (optional)

Note -

- Pants and shorts that are made with stretchy material are best to dance in (for example: leggings, track pants or P.E. shorts)
- All students are asked to wear sneakers for footwear
- Long hair is to be neatly tied up/off the face
